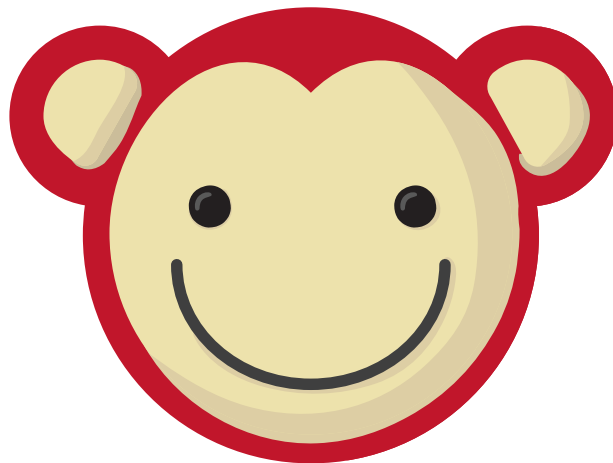
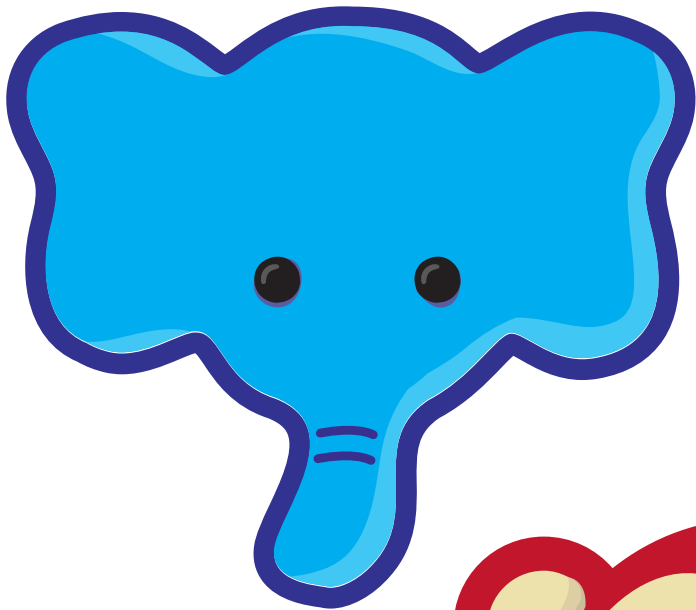




### COOKIE CUTTER TEMPLATES

Why use store bought cookie cutters when you can get your kids' creativity flowing by making your own together?

1. Print out your favourite Cookie Cutter Page.
2. Place the template on top of a piece of lightweight cardboard. Using scissors, cut around the outside edge.
3. Place the cardboard pattern over top of rolled out dough. Using a paring knife, carefully cut out the shape.
4. Collect the leftover dough scraps, roll them together and repeat until all of your dough has been used.
5. Decorate the baked cookie with icing and candies.
